**Special Issue: Language, rustle, power**

In order to close the year 2019, it is launched the *Revista Letras Raras* fourth edition of the year. The special issue **Language, rustle, power** was proposed and organised by Professors Márcio Venício Barbosa, from Federal University of Rio Grande do Norte, Brazil, Laura Taddei Brandini, from State University of Londrina, Brazil, and Claude Coste, from University of Cergy-Pontoise, France. In this edition the reader will find seven articles and one essay that highlight the invaluable work of the French master, Roland Barthes. The reader will also find six articles in the thematic section, which is also about the importance of literature and languages rustle that can promote transformations.
